

2 Corinthians 哥林多後書

Paul wrote this letter about 55 AD

 Probably written from Macedonia (1 Corinthians written from Ephesus)

可能寫自馬其頓(哥林多前書寫自以弗所)

• Letter addressed to Christians in Achaia, all of Greece south of Macedonia

致馬其頓以南希臘全境亞該亞基督徒的信

There were actually 4 letters to the Corinthians

實際上有4封寫給哥林多人的信

- 1.I Cor.5:9, 林前5:9
- 2. I Corinthians, 林前
- 3. a 'severe' letter 2 Cor. 3-4, 一封嚴厲的信 (林後3:4)
- 4.2 Corinthians 林後

• PURPOSE -- 2 Corinthians written to express joy and comfort because the Corinthians had responded well to his earlier letter.

目的-- 哥林多後書篇旨在表達喜悅和安慰,因為哥林多人對他之前的信反應良好。

 to share the genuineness of his calling as an apostle and prepare for a third visit

分享他作為使徒的真實呼召,並準備第三次訪問

- The God of all comfort 賜一切安慰的神
- The Yes of God 上帝的肯定
- Comfort in sorrow and pressure 悲傷和壓力中的安慰
- Forgiveness, the call to purity of life 寬恕,呼召過聖潔的生活
- Where the Spirit of the Lord is there is freedom 主的靈在哪裡,哪裡就有自由
- Unveiled faces reflecting the glory of God 揭示上帝榮耀的面孔

- Being changed from glory to glory 從榮耀到榮耀
- Being the aroma of Christ's triumphant procession in Jars of clay 成為陶罐中基督勝利遊行的香氣
- The eternal weight of glory, fixing our eyes not on what is seen, but what is unseen 榮耀的永恆重量,使我們的眼睛不再注視所見,而是未見的
- Our heavenly dwelling 我們天上的居所

- Seeing others from God's perspective 從上帝的角度看別人
- I am a new creation in Christ 我是基督裡新造的人
- The ministry of reconciliation, ambassadors for Christ 復和的事工,基督的使者
- Troubles hardships and distress 煩惱艱辛和苦惱
- Sorrowful yet rejoicing, having nothing but possessing everything 又悲又喜,一無所有,但樣樣都有

- Purity of life 聖潔的生活
- Harassed at every turn but comforted by God 常被騷擾,
 卻被神安慰
- Godly sorrow brings repentance and leaves no regret 敬 虔的悲傷帶來悔改,不留遺憾
- Jesus became poor that we might be rich 耶穌的貧窮, 使我們可以富足
- Generosity 慷慨

- God is able to make all grace abound 神能使一切恩典 多多
- Divine power to pull down strongholds 屬靈的力量能 摧毀營壘
- Paul's calling is genuine, through suffering, beatings, persecution 保羅的呼召是真實的,通過苦難、毆打、迫害
- Caught up into heaven, seeing God's glory 被提到天堂, 看見神的榮耀

- Thorn in the flesh 肉中刺
- Strength made perfect in weakness 祂的能力在軟弱人中變得完全
- Greet one another with a holy kiss 用聖潔的吻互相問候
- The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all 願主 耶穌基督的恩惠,神的慈愛,聖靈的交誼,常與你們同在
